

Store Lambs Report

Monday 28th September 2026

A smaller entry of 701 store lambs was forward today; however, there was no let-up in trade, with all classes selling dearer on the week. A strong wholesale average of £114 per head was achieved.

Topping the day's sale at £149 were two Texel × Mule lambs from L J Cowper, Newbridge. Suffolk lambs peaked at £135 for DW & TA Bell, High Dyke. Mule lambs sold particularly well, with M/s Marrs, Manor Farm, selling a pen of 45 lambs to £114 per head. Herdwick X lambs also met keen demand, selling to £114 for M/s Powell, Brimmer Head, while pure Herdwicks topped at £87 for a pen of 36 from C Spencer & A Langcake.
