On Monday Penrith & District Farmers' Mart LLP held their fortnightly sale of 112 Store Cattle.

What a day! Some serious demand was witnessed throughout the sale, with a very busy ringside of buyers ensuring all classes seen a considerable rise.

The sale topped at £2505 for a Limousin X heifer, 27-months-old, in good forward condition from Messrs MTP & SD Wills, Fawcett Park, purchased by Mr D Barker.

A genuine store consignment of 5 Charolais bullocks and heifers, 24-months-old and straight off the grass, averaged a very hefty £2365 from Messrs AJ Glendinning, Dacre Banks, topping at £2455 for a bullock.

Messrs A Tiffen, Wham Head Farm, sold a consignment of dairy-bred British Blue bullocks, 20 to 22-months-old to average £2150.
